TULSA INDIAN EDUCATION

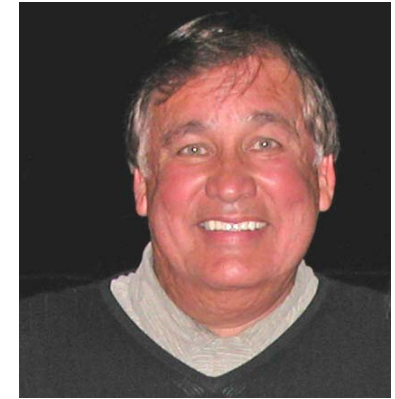
- TULSA INDIAN EDUCATION PROGRAM HAS BEEN SERVING INDIAN STUDENTS SINCE 1973

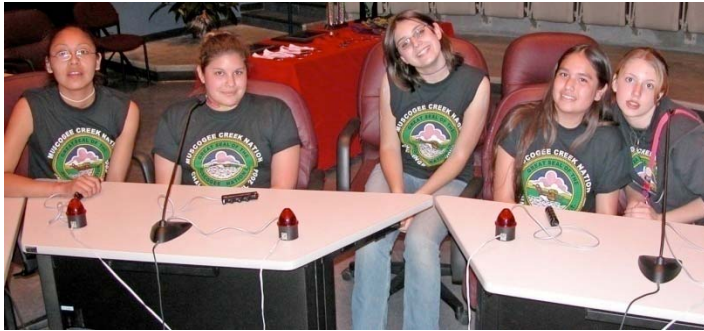

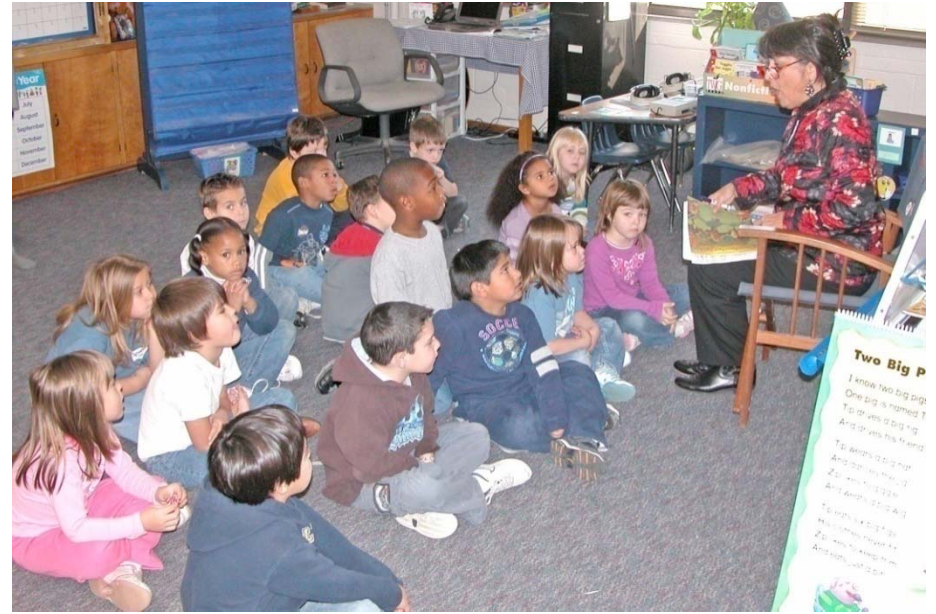

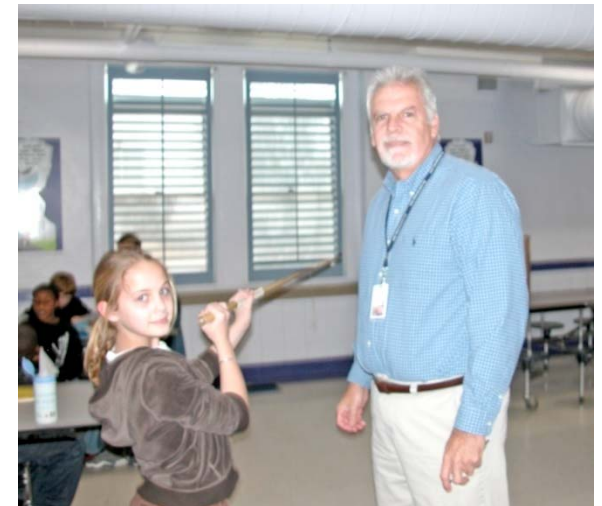
