BACK TO SCHOOL CHECKLIST

The new school year begins on **MONDAY, AUGUST 21ST,** and we can't wait to see your child in class! Use this back to school checklist to prepare for a great start to the 2017-2018 school year.

	or if you've moved over the summer and have a new neighborhood school, make sure your child is enrolled BEFORE August 21. Enroll online at www.tulsaschools.org/enroll or visit the Enrollment Center (2819 S. New Haven) Monday - Friday between 8am and 4pm.	 ATTENDANCE MATTERS and even a day or two here and there can add up. Start the school year off right and develop good attendance habits from day one: Create morning and evening routines to ease your child back into the school-year schedule. Make your school transportation plan early and create a back-up plan for emergencies. If your child will walk to school or to the bus stop, practice the route in advance.
	CHECK SCHOOL BELL-TIMES: Visit www.tulsaschools.org/belltimes to make sure you know when the day starts and ends.	
	KNOW THE BUS ROUTE: If your child will take the bus, visit www.tulsaschools.org/bus for pick-up times and bus stop locations.	
	GET SCHOOL SUPPLIES: Supply needs vary by school, so check your school's website for an up-to-date list.	 Talk to your child about the importance of getting to school on time every day.
	CHECK UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS: All schools have unique uniform needs, find yours at www.tulsaschools.org/uniforms.	
	PLAN AHEAD: We want to see your child in school every day, so use the district calendar to plan family vacations during breaks. www.tulsaschools.org/calendar
