

Magnet School/Program Transfer Instructions

Thank you for choosing Tulsa Public Schools for your family! This document is designed to give you an overview of the magnet application process, for more information visit tulsaschools.org/enroll. Please take some time to read the magnet school information provided on our website.

Applications for 2018-2019 magnet school/program transfers must be completed online at enroll.tulsaschools.org/apply/. For access to a computer or for assistance, visit the Enrollment Center between November 27 and January 19.

Application Guidelines

- Elementary students may apply for one school.
- Secondary student may apply for two schools: one criteria-based and one lottery. You will need to designate which school is your first choice. This year the criteria-based schools will select their students before the lottery schools.
- Before the application can be processed, required documents or deliverables may be uploaded to the application or hand delivered to the Enrollment Center. All completed applications must be **submitted** no later than 4:00 pm on January 19, 2018. You will receive an email when your application is complete.
- If you are applying to a criteria-based magnet program and are currently enrolled in TPS and were enrolled last year in TPS, you do not need to provide grades, test scores, attendance or discipline records.
- If you are applying to a criteria-based magnet program and are not currently enrolled in TPS and/or were not enrolled last year in TPS, you will need to provide grades, test scores, attendance and discipline records for both semesters from last year and the first semester of this year. If any of this information is not provided, the application will be marked as ineligible.

Out-of-District Applicants

Our magnet schools are in high demand – from students living both inside and outside the district boundaries. However, out-of-district applicants may not participate in the magnet school's standard lottery or admission selection process and will be admitted only through the more restricted "5% principal discretion" route. This means that out-of-district applicants may be admitted only if the principal has enough seats remaining from the small number of seats reserved for the principal to fill at his or her discretion.

- In addition, out-of-district applicants must meet the minimum qualification criteria, and can be admitted
 only after the principal has used the discretionary slots to admit any remaining qualified, in-district or outof-district applicants who are the dependents of Tulsa Public Schools employees and any other qualified indistrict applicants.
- Qualified out-of-district students not admitted through the principal discretion process will be placed at the end of the school's waiting list after any qualified in-district students.
- For applicants to elementary magnet schools only: The restrictions on out-of-district admission apply even if the applicant has an older sibling currently attending the school.

^{*}If current TPS student, information will be pulled from Powerschool and provided to committees. If student is not currently enrolled in TPS or was not enrolled last year in TPS, the Guardian is responsible for collecting all of the information and bringing it to the Enrollment Center. The application will be marked ineligible if missing any required information.

#If applicant has never attended TPS, student must provide birth certificate, immunizations, and all required documents listed above.

Students who live out of district must also complete an Out of District Transfer application and submit it to the Enrollment Center no later than January 19, 2018. Students living out of district will be considered according to the requirements of regulation 2206-R2.
