## **Grants with Upcoming Deadlines**

#### General School/Classroom

**General School/Classroom (PK-12):** \$2,000 or \$5,000 to fund resource materials, supplies, equipment, transportation, software, or scholars-in-residence in order to improve the academic achievement of students in any subject area(s). Grantor: The NEA Foundation Student Achievement

Deadline: Feb 1

Service Learning (18 and under): up to \$1,000 to support student-led service learning projects Grantor: <u>Karma for Cara Foundation</u> Deadline: July 1, Oct 1, Jan 1, April 1

Service Learning (PK-12): up to \$200 to support people, animals, or environmental projects Grantor: Jane Goodall's Roots and Shoots Deadline: Sept 11, Oct 30, Jan 22, Mar 19

**General School/Classroom (PK-12):** \$10,000 per year for three years to fund programs that nurture the intellectual, artistic and creative abilities of low-income children Grantor: McCarthey Dressman Education Foundation – <u>Academic Enrichment Grant</u> Deadline: Jan 15 - Apr 15

#### Reading/Literacy

**Reading/Language Arts Classrooms (K-6):** \$2500 to support the teaching and learning of reading and writing, across the curriculum in real-world contexts Grantor: International Literacy Association – <u>Regie</u> <u>Routman Teacher Recognition Grant</u> Deadline: Jan 15

Libraries (PK-12): up to \$500 to support school libraries Grantor: Ezra Jack Keats Foundation – <u>Mini Grants</u> Deadline: March 31

Youth Literacy (K-12): funding to support implementation or expansion of Summer Reading Programs for students who are new readers, below grade level or experiencing difficulty reading

Grantor: Dollar General Literacy Found <u>Summer Reading</u> Deadline: available in Jan

**Adult Literacy:** funding to nonprofit organizations that provide direct service to adults in need of literacy assistance: adult basic education, general education diploma preparation, English language acquisition. Grantor: Dollar General Literacy Found <u>Adult Literacy</u> Deadline: available in Jan

**Family Literacy:** funding to nonprofit organizations that provide family literacy services such as adult education instruction, children's education, parent and child together time, and parenting classes Grantor: Dollar General Literacy Found <u>Family Literacy</u> Deadline: available in Jan Libraries (PK-12): new book, video, audiobook, recording donations (value up to \$10,000) Grantor: ALSC – <u>Bookapalooza Program</u> Deadline: Feb 1

#### Math/Science

Science Field Trips (PK-12): funding to cover the costs of transportation and tickets to the Oklahoma Aquarium. Funders request you exhaust other funding options first Grantor: <u>Fish Friends Scholarship Fund</u> Deadline: Ongoing

Science Field Trips (PK-12): Funding to help pay for admission and fuel costs to plan a visit to the Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural History. Grantor: <u>Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural</u> <u>History Fossil Fuel Fund</u> Deadline: Sept-May, first of each month

Agriculture/Science Classrooms (PK-8): up to \$300 to promote student understanding of food and fiber systems and agricultural literacy Grantor: Oklahoma Ag in the Classroom Grant Deadline: Sept 15 and Jan 30

**STEM Classrooms (K-12):** \$250 to promote aeronautics/astronautics in the classroom Grantor: American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics – <u>Classroom Grant Program</u> Deadline: Oct 1 - Jan 5

**Gardens/Outdoor Classrooms (3):** free cabbage plant to every third grade student in an applying classroom to foster an interest in gardening and the environment. Each plant will produce a mega-oversized cabbage head. One student in each state will win \$1,000 for their cabbage each year.

Grantor: Bonnie's Plants – <u>3rd Grade Cabbage Program</u> Deadline: prior to growing season

**STEM Classrooms (K-12):** \$10,000 sweepstakes for science lab makeover and/or STEM equipment and supplies Grantor: Siemens – <u>Possibility Grant Sweepstakes</u> Deadline: Apr 27

**Environment (1-12):** funding to support ecoSolutions, ecoTech, and ecoSTEMKits grants for hands-on involvement and understanding of environmental issues Grantor: <u>Captain Planet Foundation</u> Deadline: Jan 15 and July 15

#### Arts/Music/Theater

Arts Classrooms/Libraries: (PK-12): free books on contemporary art and culture to rural or inner-city schools, libraries, and alternative reading centers Grantor: Distribution to Underserved Communities (DUC) Library Program Deadline: Ongoing

Arts (K-6): up to \$300 for elementary theater productions Grantor: The Lovett Foundation – <u>Elementary Drama Fund</u> Deadline: opens every August

Arts/History Classrooms/Field Trips (PK-12): scholarships for 100% of student admission and up to \$200 reimbursement for bus expenses to the Mabee-Gerrer Museum of Art Grantor: Mabee-Gerrer Museum of Art – <u>Field Trips</u> Deadline: Ongoing

#### Health/Fitness

Health and Fitness (6-8): funding to provide uniforms and equipment for established after-school sports programs Grantor: Justin J. Watt Foundation Deadline: applications reviewed Mar, June, Sept, Dec



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#### **Professional Development**

#### Professional Development/Teacher Travel (PK-12):

\$5,000 for individuals, \$10,000 for teams to support selfdesigned professional growth to teachers during national or international travel during the summer, which in turn inspires potential in their students. Grantor: <u>Fund for Teachers</u> Deadline: Oct 1 – Jan 31

History Professional Development (K-12): travel stipend and boarding on site at Mt. Vernon to spend 4 days to one week in intensive study of the founding of America and George Washington's role in it at the Mt. Vernon Spring and Summer Residential Teachers Institute Grantor: Mt. Vernon - <u>Residential Programs</u> Deadline: Jan 29

History Professional Development (5 and 8): travel scholarship and \$300 in classroom materials to attend the 8-day Colonial Williamsburg Teachers Institute to study early colonial period of American history Grantor: Oklahoma Foundation for Excellence – <u>Colonial Williamsburg Teacher Institute</u> Deadline: Feb 1

Social Studies Professional Development (7-12): funding for teachers to study at the US Holocaust Memorial Museum during the summer Grantor: US Holocaust Memorial Museum – <u>Museum</u> <u>Teacher Fellowship Program</u> Deadline: Feb 16

**Social Studies Professional Development (7-12):** \$7,000 for teachers with experience using CSPAN classroom resources to attend 4-week summer fellowship in DC where teachers help CSPAN develop new teaching materials

Grantor: C-SPAN – <u>Teacher Fellowship Program</u> Deadline: Mar 2

**Technology Professional Development (K-12):** Bring an EdTechTeam member to your school to offer highquality professional development in technology use Grantor: EdTechTeam – <u>Committed Giving Program</u> Deadline: Ongoing, awarded quarterly

**Environmental Professional Development (K-12):** 7-14 day travel and environmental study experience (world locations change each year), all expenses paid except for travel to and from location, travel grant awarded to offset travel costs

Grantor: Earthwatch Institute – <u>Teach Earth</u> Deadline: Jan 8

**Professional Development (K-12):** up to \$10,000 (\$30,000 over three years) for small groups to develop and implement groundbreaking classroom instruction Grantor: McCarthey Dressman <u>Teacher Development</u> Deadline: Apr 15

## **Featured General Classroom Grants!**

The grants featured in this section often do not have a specific deadline and accept applications at any time. They also tend to fund the widest variety of projects.

**Teacher and Classroom Resources (PK-12):** Various websites offering education trunks, teacher resources, lesson plans, primary sources, essay contests, virtual tours (some have sponsorships and fee waivers for class trips) from various museums and online sources

School and Classroom Supplies (PK-12): online partnership between donor and classroom to fund classroom projects, supplies, field trips, etc. Grantor: Adopt-a-Classroom Deadline: Ongoing

School and Classroom Supplies (PK-12): create a wish list of supplies that parents, alumni, and other supporters can contribute tax-exempt funds to fulfill your wish list Grantor: <u>Classwish</u> Deadline: Ongoing

School and Classroom Supplies/Technology (PK-12): Digital Wish – similar to Donors Choose but focused on technology, also includes monthly grant awards for submitted lesson plans (lesson plans are shared and searchable) Grantor: <u>Digital Wish</u> Deadline: Ongoing

School and Classroom Supplies (PK-12): Register for classroom and project materials that donors may select to fund. Grantor: <u>DonorsChoose</u> Deadline: Ongoing TPS Board Policy 5803 requires that all private and foundational funders are sent a note of thanks.

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
