Field Trips (K-12): up to \$700 for field trip expenses Grantor: Target Foundation – <u>Target Field Trip Grant</u> Deadline: Aug 1 – Oct 1

Student Travel: Register your class or club trip providing multiple funders with the opportunity to donate through a tax-exempt organization Grantor: <u>DonorsChoose</u> Deadline: Ongoing

Music Field Trips (K-12): \$500 for student tickets to attend live performances of classical music Grantor: <u>The Sharon Gerwitz Kids to Concerts Fund</u> Deadline: June 30

Arts (K-12): up to \$3,000 to support arts in schools Grantor: The Lovett Foundation – <u>Regular Arts Grant</u> Deadline: July 31

Arts (K-6): up to \$300 for elementary theater productions Grantor: The Lovett Foundation – <u>Elementary Drama</u> <u>Fund</u> Deadline: opens every August

Special Education

Tourette Syndrome (PK-12): funding to support programming that helps children with Tourette Syndrome learn how to live in the real world with others who don't understand Grantor: <u>Brad Cohen Tourette Foundation</u> Deadline: Mar 1 and Sept 1

Hearing Impaired (PK-12): hearing aids and/or assisted hearing devices for student with demonstrated financial need. Applications made individually for each student Grantor: <u>The HIKE (Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment)</u> Fund

Deadline: Ongoing

Vision Impaired (PK-12): free eye exams and eye glasses for low income, uninsured students. Applications made individually for each student Grantor: VSP Global - <u>Sight for Students</u> Deadline: Ongoing

Professional Development

Arts/Music/Theater PD (PK-12): \$500 to attend a state/national conference for music, art, speech, debate, drama, theater, or dance Grantor: <u>OK Alliance of Arts Educators</u> Deadline: Aug 1
