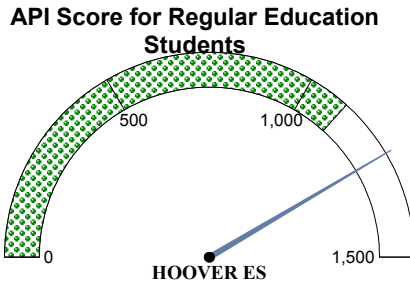


**HOOVER ES****No Child Left Behind Act Annual Report Card 2009-2010****Academic Performance Index (API) and Accountability Data**

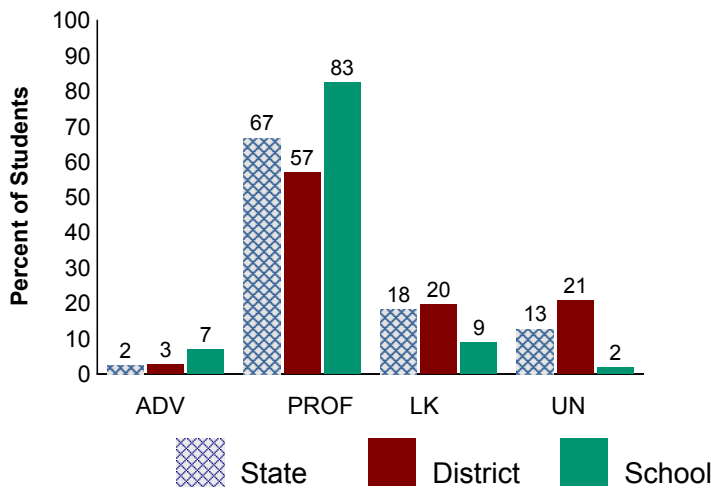

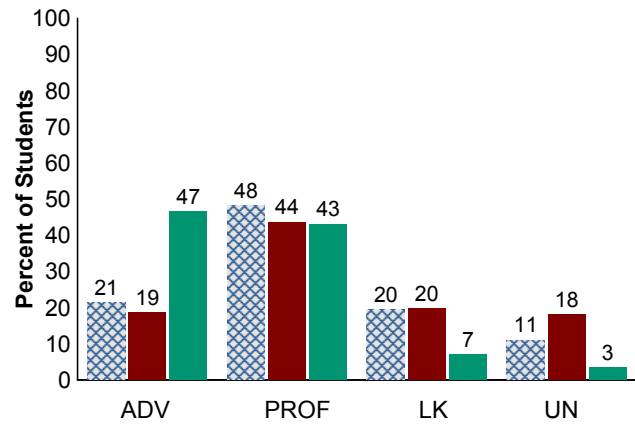
**State, District and School Reading Results**

**State, District and School Math Results**

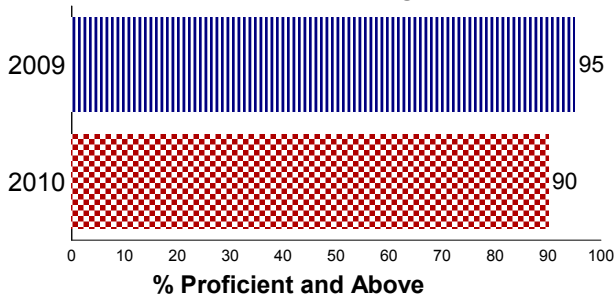

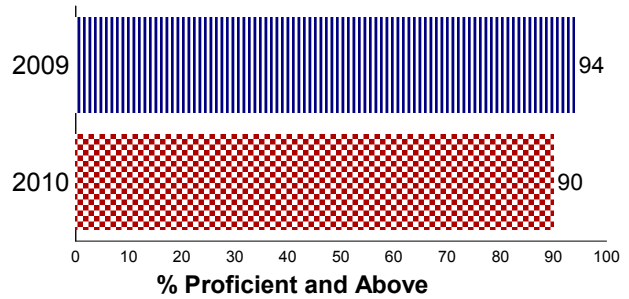

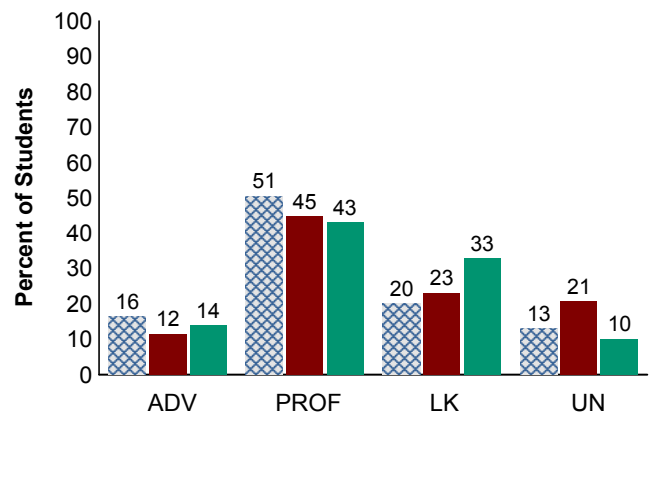
**State, District and School Reading Results**

All Students Tested



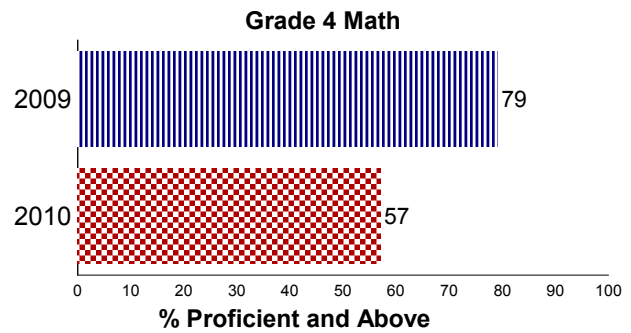
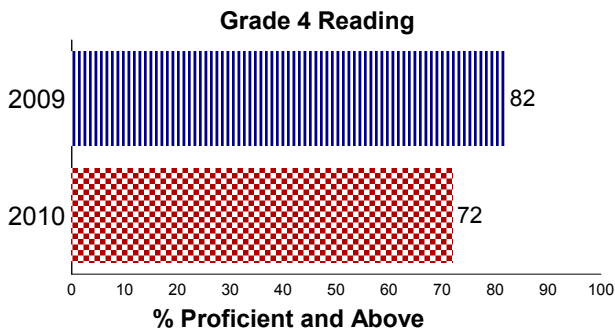

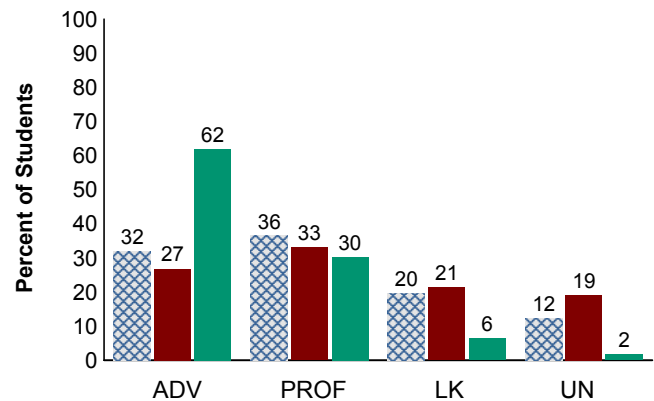
**State, District and School Reading Results**

**State, District and School Math Results**

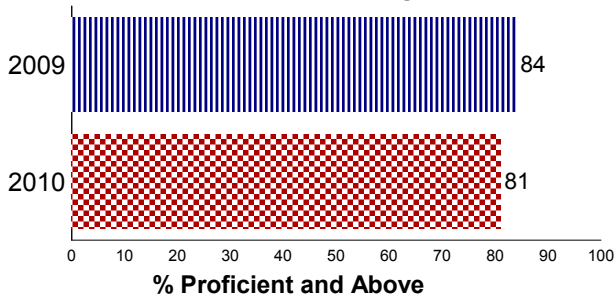

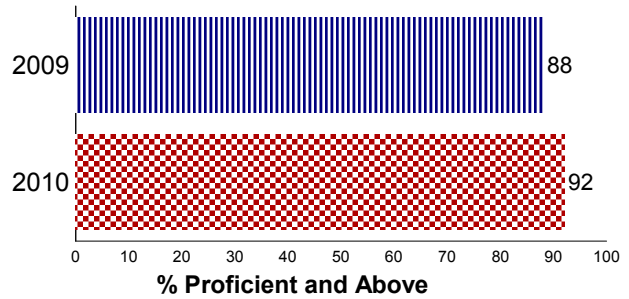
