Rodger Randle called the meeting to order at 12:05 p.m. Introduced Glenda Silvey, as the New Co-Chairman for the Oversight Committee.

Peggy Spillman made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as written. Ernesto Mondragon seconded. All approved.

### Bob LaBass gave an update on the Facilites Bond.

Eisenhower : completing punch list items and starting the paving for the new parking lots.

Enrollment Center is in the process of laying dirt work for the parking lot and drive way, which will allow people to get around and not pile up in the neighborhood.

Memorial field house is moving right along as scheduled and should be completed by February 15, 2014. School raised money to buy flags for the outside flag poles. New parking lot and lighting is still to be done and will be considered Phase II and will consist of surveying the parking lot and redoing the lighting. The parking lot will have one big center light right in the middle of the lot.

Lafortune stadium is almost completed. Still working on the concession stand for Softball, due to the water line break to the baseball field. Bo commented that the ADA at the stadium is wonderful. Also, working on replacing the turf due to bad turf that was installed around 6 years ago with Field Turf, which will be a higher grade than before and will receive a new 8 year warranty. This will begin after football season.

Salk Library/Classroom addition: Project is almost finished. Still have some duct revision on some old classrooms, due to the sewer backing up which was blamed on construction. The sewer lines will be added on the south side of the building.

McBirney: Work has started. We have been working with the City on cutting down a number of trees and everything is going as planned.

Bunche ECDC: Adding extra bathrooms and sprinklers to the building to get up to code. Library renovations are going on as well. New shelving and basically updating the space.

East Central Locker Room: Each stadium will have visitors' locker rooms, two for males and two for females.

Lindbergh & Mitchell library: Just getting approvals from city. There was a delay with the permits but should have both schools in the next two weeks. Both libraries are hardened rooms and are also storm shelters. Shelters meet the FEMA requirements and by 2015 safe rooms will be state required. A bond passed at state level would help with costs.

Windows/Doors: Still doing plenty of windows. Contractor having to work at night so it takes a little longer to complete the project.

### HVAC/Security/Playground

Last 15 schools will be done by the end of the year. The bus barn, etc. will be on next round.

<u>Ellen Duecker gave an update on the Classroom Bond.</u> 243 Interactive Whiteboards have been installed in classrooms where the whiteboards were either missing or broken.

<u>Ellen Duecker gave an update on the Library Bond.</u> Construction to begin on Lindbergh & Mitchell. Design meetings underway for new library at East Central J.H.

Next board meeting we will have Architect to look at old Bunche & old Mayo building to do a remodel.

Exploring the next bond, we will start putting a committee together after the first of the year. This will be a large bond due to technical improvements and also facility repairs.

Blaine gave a thorough update on where they are on the Technology Bond.

# The next meeting will be held at 12:00 p.m. on March 27, 2014 in the Superintendents Conference Room on the second floor.

Motion was made by Glenda Silvey to adjourn. Ernesto Mondragon seconded. Meeting adjourned at 12:56 p.m.

## **Project School House**

Eisenhower at Nimitz: Finalizing punch list items and new parking lots.

Enrollment Center: Heavy interior activity continues, outside dirt work and new drive completed, considerable redesign of spaces has resulted in the opening being pushed to early March.

# FACILITIES BOND

- CONSTRUCTION
  - Memorial Field House: Project continues on schedule, aux gym floor being installed this week, main floor down, interior finishes continue. The completion date for the field house is February 15, 2014.
  - LaFortune Stadium/S.E. Williams Stadiums: Installation of both replacement fields nearing completion, await inspection approval.
  - Salk Library and Classroom Addition: Replacement sanitary sewer line installed and complete.
  - McBirney Transportation Building: Steel is up, exterior work underway, looking at Feb/Mar completion.
  - Bunch ECDC Restroom Additions: Sprinkler installation nearing completion, beginning to enclose restroom pods.
  - East Central/Hale Locker Room: Slab is down, wall construction is underway.
  - Lindbergh and Mitchell Library Additions: Work underway at Lindberg with permit just released at Mitchell this week.
  - Developing bid documents for infilling pools at Anderson, Hamilton, Bell Jr. High, Chouteau and Lewis and Clark. These spaces will be developed into 16 additional classrooms.
- PROJECTS

- WINDOWS/DOORS: MacArthur and Lee nearing completion, many sites in punch status, i.e. Bell, Celia Clinton, Academy Central, Anderson, Burroughs, etc. New projects starting at Cooper, Disney, Emerson and Columbus.
- ROOFING: Porter (Built up gym roof) and ESC (warranty replacement)
- HVAC/ Security: Preparing bid document for upcoming HVAC replacement at Central. For this project we will be installing LED lighting throughout that are estimated to save 65% in lighting costs. Project will be complete in time for fall semester. Elementary security install completed, Alternative sites will start with March funding.

## **CLASSROOM BOND**

• Fine arts funds being expended for the sites.

## LIBRARY BOND

• Per above, construction set to begin on Library addition at Lindbergh and Mitchell Elementary. Sites are developing their technology orders.

## • <u>SMART AND SECURE BOND</u>

- ELECTRICAL / SERVER ROOM UPGRADES
  - Installation of electrical and data outlets at schools are continuing as school technology needs are identified. To date, 39 electrical and data installations have been completed.
- DISTRICT WIRELESS
  - Wireless infrastructure installed at 81 school locations. Invoice and payment completed at 46 locations and remediation efforts are continuing. The Transportation

complex and the Education Service Center are the only remaining sites and will be completed in February.

- INTERNET INFRASTRUCTURE
  - Firewall and Filtering products have been purchased and the installation of these systems is in progress. Cutover to these new systems is tentatively scheduled for completion January 20<sup>th</sup>.
- INSTRUCTIONAL LEARNING SYSTEMS
  - Professional Development and Curriculum and Instruction are developing the website Technology Training for the Standard Classroom which offers tutorials, online training, and links to face-to-face professional development.
- MANAGED PRINT SERVICES
  - Site Assessments and recommendations for centralized printing (fleet) are in process at 20 sites. Five sites have been optimized; ESC 6<sup>th</sup> floor, ESC Benefits, Mayo, Marshall, and Gilcrease. To assist schools, a <u>one-time</u> supplement of \$3.68 per student will be applied towards "click" charges and will be rolled into the initial cost of the equipment.
- DISTRICT WIDE SECURITY AND MAINTENANCE
  - Classroom Phones
    - Deployment of phones to elementary schools is in progress. 4 sites targeted for completion this week. Still pending completion of assessments for high-schools and alternative sites.
  - Alarm Panel Upgrade and SCADA system Replacement
    - Request for Proposal (RFP) for SCADA system replacement being published on January 14<sup>th</sup>.
      Funding will be available in March. Target February 2<sup>nd</sup> to publish RFP for alarm panel replacement.
      Funding will be available in August. 90 sites will have alarm panels upgraded or replaced.
- STUDENT & TEACHER COMPUTERS AND TABLETS
  - Sites are submitting technology purchase requests, focusing on Scholastic programs and online testing. Site technology requisitions are due January 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - The Information Technology team is meeting individually with each site to review their site technology plan.
- INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARD

- Whiteboards for 19 of the 33 sites in Phase 3 have been deployed. Currently still on target to complete all 33 sites by end of January. Five additional sites have been added to this phase because of priority need. Scheduling is pending for these sites. These additional sites are targeted to be completed in February.
- SPRINKLER SYSTEMS
  - Sites to be addressed in a future allocation.
