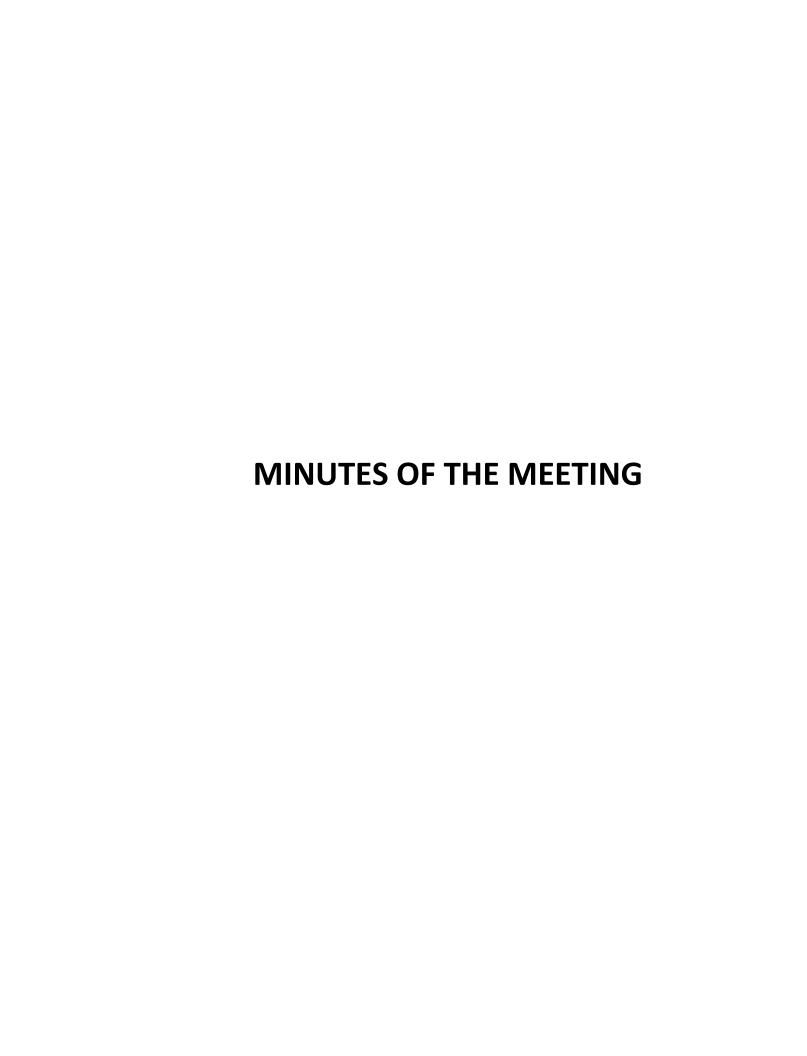

Barney James made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as written. Peggy Spillman seconded. All approved.

Bob LaBass gave an update on the Facilites Bond.

Memorial Field House: New parking lot and lighting completed. Floor sanded & refinished over break along with HVAC was fixed.

Edison Classroom Addition: Having problems getting permits. Project should be complete by January 2016.

East Central/ Hale Locker Room: Problem with moisture in slab at East Central. They are leaving the locker room open until this summer, to see if it will dry out.

Lindbergh: Project should be complete this week.

Mitchell: Still working on the interior of both the classroom and library.

Pool Repurposing: First phase has been completed for Anderson, Lewis and Clark, Hamilton, Chouteau, and Hale Jr. High School. Phase II for Bell, Gilcrease, East Central Jr. High, and Skelly will bid February 20th.

Dual Language Immersion: Had a fire there this morning, due to a cigarette butt. Minimal damage was done. The cigarette burned a hole in the gym floor, which was going to be replaced anyways.

East Tulsa Expansion: Getting building permit & working on the interior walls. Drilling piers and footing on the new addition. Old addition should be complete by August.

Windows/Doors: Hawthorne, Jackson & ECDC Bunche are underway. Patrick Henry is complete and looks great.

Bob LaBass gave an update on the Classroom Bond.

Auditorium chair replacement scheduled at Memorial, Monroe, Webster, and Hale Jr.

New allocations on the textbook and technology are now to be distributed to the sites.

Ellen Duecker gave an update on the Library Bond.

Librarians are on track for spending Library Book and Technology funds by February 13, 2015.

Mitchell Elementary: Library and Classroom to be complete by February.

Bell Elementary: Library remodel is scheduled for completion February 6th with shelving installation by February 15th.

East Central Junior High: Recently broke ground & will be working on the project for the next 6 months.

Lee & Jackson library is scheduled for renovations.

Blaine gave a thorough update on where they are on the Technology Bond.

The next meeting will be held at 12:00 p.m. on March 19, 2015 at ESC.

Motion was made by Glenda Silvey to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 12:37 p.m.

2010 Bond

FACILITIES BOND

CONSTRUCTION

- First floor walls installation underway. Electrical work upgrade to distribution system to support additional load underway. Reviewing of exterior finishes and submittals under way.
- o East Central/Hale Locker Room: Complete
- Mitchell: New classroom portion move in complete, addressing punch list and exterior grading. Demolition complete of old library complete, and being converted to two additional classrooms. Schedule being converted for removals of modular units.
- Pool conversion: Awaiting city permit approval on First phase. 2nd phases to be bid in February for Bell, Gilcrease, East Central Jr. High, and Skelly.
- Dual Language relocation (Old Bunch): HVAC installation complete, installation new kitchen mechanical underway, interior refinishes underway.
- East Tulsa Expansion (Old Mayo): Renovation of existing space underway. Permits issued on expansion space with piers and beams and precast panels for storm shelter installed.
- WINDOWS/DOORS: Projects nearing completion at Hawthorne, Jackson, Patrick Henry, DLI, and Penn.

CLASSROOM BOND

- Auditorium chair bids will be taken 3-24 for Memorial, Monroe, Webster, and Hale Jr.
- Allocations for fine arts textbooks being addressed textbook and technology have been distributed.

LIBRARY BOND

- Mitchell library complete with repurposing of old library underway.
- o Bell Elementary: Complete remodel complete by April.
- East Central Jr High: Slab pour complete, access control relocated, looking at August 1 substantial completion.

TRANSPORTATION

 Used buses have been received and placed into service, service vehicles placed on Agenda, finalizing specifications for ordering new yellow buses.

2015 BOND

All four issues of the 2015 Bond passed with over an 85 % voter approval. Initial fund distribution of \$10 million will occur fall of 2015 with next allocation of \$54 million to be received fall of 2016.

2013 BOND

• SMART AND SECURE BOND

- ELECTRICAL / SERVER ROOM UPGRADES
 - Installation of electrical and data outlets at schools are continuing as school technology needs are identified. To date, 192 electrical and data installations have been completed.
- DISTRICT WIRELESS
 - Wireless project infrastructure implementation is complete.
- INTERNET INFRASTRUCTURE
 - Firewall and Filtering project is complete.
- INSTRUCTIONAL LEARNING SYSTEMS

- A three-day technology conference for TPS teachers will be offered at Wilson Teaching and Learning Academy from June 9th through June 11th.
- Summer professional development for integrating technology into different curriculum areas and grade levels will be provided.

MANAGED PRINT SERVICES

• 79 Sites installed to date. The remaining sites are targeted to be installed by June 2015.

DISTRICT WIDE SECURITY AND MAINTENANCE

- Classroom Phones
 - All classrooms had phones installed by the end of the last school year. The District's new phone system implementation is underway funded by the 2010 Bond.
- SCADA System Replacement
 - Project is 40% complete. Targeted project completion is January 2016.
- Alarm Panel Replacements
 - 8 full fire replacements have been completed:
 Addams, Central Junior & Senior High School,
 Enrollment Center, Key, Lindbergh, Mitchell, Patrick
 Henry, and McBirney.
 - Alarm replacement on the intrusion alarms at 16 sites. A Request For Proposal will be submitted for the next four sites.

STUDENT & TEACHER COMPUTERS AND TABLETS

- The final allocation will be received by schools in January 2015.
- All new computer purchases include installation services. 4945 computers have been installed. A total of 2146 computers are in planning / implementation at 68 sites.

INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARD

• Project is 78% complete. 20 of 87 installations remaining with targeted completion of June 2015.

SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

 Bids have gone out for Lanier, Eliot and Springdale. Bids were accepted for Burroughs, Lombard and Street School. Installations targeted to begin the summer of 2015.
