- Perform other tasks, duties, or services consistent with this position as assigned

 - installing fixtures/equipment
 - measuring, cutting and installing conduits in specified panels
 - o testing continuity of circuits and repairing faulty systems
 - o lifting and moving supplies, equipment and materials
 - wearing protective clothing as required by the work environment or governmental regulations

Supervisory Responsibility:

• The electrician may supervise, train and coordinate the activities of workers installing, maintaining and repairing electrical apparatus

Working Conditions: Exposure to the following situations may range from remote to frequent based on circumstances and factors that may not be predictable.

- Inside and outside work in all conditions
- Extreme weather conditions (heat/cold)
- Confined space entry
