TNTP seeks summer **Pre-Service Training Instructors** for Tulsa Teacher Corps. This position is based in Tulsa, Oklahoma and is available in Summer 2018.

Tulsa Teacher Corps prepares Corps Members to achieve immediate, measurable success with their students in the fall. Our training approach, called Fast Start, focuses on foundational skills that we believe Corps Members must have to ensure a strong start to the school year as a new teacher. During their pre-service training, Corps Members rehearse the foundational skills, receive coaching, and practice them with students. Corps Members must demonstrate proficiency in these skills in order to successfully complete pre-service training and become a teacher of record in the fall.

What You'll Do

Instructors lead skill-building sessions focused on the foundational skills of pre-service training, ensuring Corps Members have high quality opportunities to both learn and practice the skills. In addition, Instructors design and facilitate sessions that support Corps Members' ability to plan and execute instruction.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Internalize *Teach Like a Champion* and the principles of effective practice with the techniques
- Internalize Zaretta Hammond's *Culturally Responsive Teaching and the Brain* to ensure Corps Members use the TLAC techniques in the classroom in concert with deep relationships and meaningful content
- Internalize Tulsa Public Schools Learning Expectations
- Plan and facilitate daily skill-building sessions based on *Teach Like a Champion* and *Culturally Responsive Teaching and the Brain* for two groups of Corps Members, including:
 - Expertly modeling *Teach Like a Champion* techniques so that Corps Members understand the essential components of the techniques and their impact on student learning
 - Leading Corps Members in analyzing the *Teach Like a Champion* techniques
 - Modeling and providing feedback on how to deliver Teach Like a Champion techniques through each students' frame
 - o Providing targeted, actionable feedback to Corps Members on their practice of the techniques
 - Maintaining high levels of session rigor through skillful facilitation
- Plan and facilitate collaborative planning sessions for two groups of Corps Members, that include designing and leading weekly lesson planning sessions that support Corps Members' acquisition of instructional planning skills
- Identify and communicate trends in Corps Member performance by communicating performance trends to Teacher Development Coaches, who work with smaller groups of Corps Members to further develop skills in the classroom
- Meet with other PST team members to plan meaningful training activities and norm on Corps Member performance standards

Qualifications

- Minimum two years of successful teaching experience in high-need subject areas (required)
- Strong familiarity and experience with Eureka and/or CKLA curriculum (highly preferred)
- Familiarity with Tulsa and the history of education in Tulsa (highly preferred)
- Experience with Teach Like a Champion techniques (highly preferred)
- Experience with No-Nonsense Nurturing techniques (highly preferred)
- Experience with culturally responsive teaching (highly preferred)
- · Demonstrated ability to motivate and inspire students and adults
- Experience and comfort providing direct, in-the-moment feedback to teachers, both written and verbal, that leads to immediate improvement
- Experience in facilitating effective training experiences for adult learners
- Demonstrated ability to connect with adult learners quickly and to build strong working and mentoring relationships
- Exceptional skills in time management, including the ability to balance multiple priorities in a fast-paced work environment
- · Readiness to work non-standard hours over the course of the pre-service training (35 hours per week)
- A positive outlook, flexibility, and sense of possibility in stressful situations
- Evidence of working successfully in teams or cooperative settings
- Strong analytical skills, including the ability to utilize quantitative and qualitative analysis to support decision-making

What We Offer

TNTP offers a competitive hourly wage commensurate with experience in a similar position. Pre-Service Training Instructors' hourly wage is \$30 per hour. TNTP offers a motivated team of dynamic colleagues, a collegial atmosphere that values professional development and valuable feedback, and the chance to impact the direction of a growing, mission-driven company that is committed to the success of our nation's children. We also offer an inclusive environment where staff are encouraged to bring their whole selves to work each day.

Time Commitment

Pre-Service Training Instructors can expect up to 40 hours of training over multiple days in the spring in the summer. Pre-Service Training Instructors are focused on preparation work in advance of pre-service training and a full-time commitment of 30 – 40 hours/week for the five weeks of pre-service training.
