Job Objectives: Provide communication and/or educational access utilizing sign language for deaf/hard of hearing students and adults in the role of a sign language interpreter or a deaf education teacher.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Qualifications: as set forth in the Educational Interpreter for the Deaf Act (70 O.S. & 13-115.3) and the State Board of Education rules (OAC 210:15 -13-) are summarized below:
 - o Completed one of the following:
 - An interpreter training program
 - Obtained a Bachelor's degree
 - Worked three or more years in are related to the field of deaf education, which would include interpreting in non-educational settings, such as a church, etc.
 - o And hold at least one of the following certifications:
 - Certification by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID),
 - National Association for the Deaf (NAD) Level IV or better
 - Quality Assurance Screening Test (QAST) Level of III or better
 - Signed Exact English Level 3.5 or better,
 - National Council for Interpreters (NIC) Certification,
 - Educational Interpreters Proficiency Assessment (EIPA) Level 3.5 or better
 - o (If you have a level of QAST I or II or EIPA below 3.5 and fall under the provision of having been a recent graduate, you may qualify as well)

Responsibilities and Essential Functions: The following duties are representative of performance expectations. A reasonable accommodation may be made to enable a qualified individual with a disability to perform essential functions.
